Safety and Education Report —Rich and Andy have taught or were scheduled to teach at O'Fallon, Mascoutah, Dupo, Columbia, Collinsville, Granite City and East St. Louis. Thirty-four years ago, about a dozen guys and girls from the Belleville area were meeting with about twenty others from the Sparta area to start a new chapter in that area. We didn't have enough interested bikers from this area to start an ABATE Chapter, so we went to Sparta and pitched in with that crew to start the Backroads #32 Chapter. Approximately nine months later in May, we held our first organizational meeting at a little bar next to Scott Air Force Base called Sandy's Runway. Before the night was over, we had thirty-five members and a new ABATE Chapter without a name. They called us the St Clair County Chapter for the time being until we could decide on a name. Well, that name appealed to the majority of us, but it didn't come without a fight! Our newly elected activities officer even had a shirt made up that said "Freedom Chapter" on the back. I still have that shirt around here somewhere. I recall us meeting at The Hog Shack or The Hog Shed, I can't recall the exact name. We would use their phone and call the Illinois State Capitol to talk to our Representative and Senators and pass the phone around to everybody. At the meetings we signed postcards and talked about how to write letters and talking points when talking or writing to them. The ongoing helmet law bills were all the rage back then. LEGISLATIVE REPORT


I'm guessing everybody has heard by now that we had the first "Helmet Law Bill" legislation in a long time introduced recently. It is HB5620 Vehicle Code Motorcycle Helmets. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Requires the operator of a motorcycle, motor driven cycle, or moped and all passengers to wear a motorcycle helmet. Defines "motorcycle helmet". It was introduced into the Rules Committee in February and on April 2nd it was moved to the Transportation Vehicles & Safety Committee. In just a few short days we generated over three-hundred witness slips opposing it. It was obvious that it was going to be a very unpopular bill to try to push in an election year. And just like that, it was sent back to rules committee, rumored to be rewritten as an 18 or 21 and under helmet bill. For now it is just sitting there in limbo. For curiosity I followed it to the rules committee to see what was going on. They have somewhere around

three-hundred bills sitting in that committee awaiting some type of action by the members of that committee. There is five members in that committee. It should die a long slow death, but we will keep an eye on it. Mike Gallagher

SAFETY & ED REPORT

Rich and I have taught or were scheduled to teach at O'Fallon, Mascoutah, Dupo, Columbia, Collinsville, Granite City and East St Louis High School Drivers Education Classes. We did hear back from Belleville and were too busy to teach there this semester but will get back there in the fall. Rich and I are spread thin, and we're looking for some help to assist in reaching out to these students and teach these classes. It is a one-hour presentation in a driver's education class and is very rewarding. We're in the riding season with a lot of bikes out. The farmers are also out on the roads so keep an eye out for them as they are very unpredictable. Most farm equipment is not required to have turn signals. Some roads have some pretty deep potholes so be aware of that especially at night. You can report potholes on state routes to IDOT Headquarters switchboard at 618-346-3100. Report county and township road problems to the local authorities.


